

Update on the construction of Paytherden Solar Farm – October 2025

The first phase of the construction of the solar farm is now complete. Over the course of the summer months, the site team have built the temporary construction compound and the access off Marsh Cross. The archaeological works have been undertaken as planned, and the archaeologist is preparing their report for review by the County Archaeologist at Devon County Council, as per the agreed planning conditions. With these works now carried out, the site has been demobilised until the main build phase. This means that over the coming months, there will be no heavy transport vehicles going to and from the site. Bluefield will provide notice to the local community on any upcoming construction traffic movements through the village. In the meantime, should you have any concerns regarding lorries passing through the village, please be advised that these are associated with another construction project in the area.
